TERMS & CONDITIONS

Eastern Shores International (ESI) will contact you or your agent to confirm your accommodation and airport reception arrangements. If any details are inaccurate you should contact ESI immediately.

Homestay fees are required to be paid in advance prior to students' arrival to homestay for the first 4 weeks of accommodation. Students may wish to extend after the original booking period, either you or your agent must inform ESI of your extension and we will issue your next invoice and contact to your host to ensure there is a vacancy for you.

CANCELLATION & POSTPONEMENT POLICY

- If you **POSTPONE** or **CANCEL** your accommodation booking more than two (2) weeks before your arrival, you will be charged \$100 to cover administration costs, but your Homestay Placement fee, Accommodation Fees and Airport Transfer fee will be refunded (minus the \$100 administration costs).
- If you **POSTPONE** your accommodation less than two (2) weeks before your arrival, you will be charged \$100 to cover administration costs.
- If you CANCEL your accommodation booking less than two (2) weeks before your arrival, you will be charged \$100 to cover administration costs, your Accommodation Fees and Airport Transfer fee will be refunded but your Placement Fee will NOT be refunded.
- If you **POSTPONE** your accommodation booking less than 48 hours before your arrival, you will be charged \$100 to cover administration costs and one (1) weeks Accommodation Fee (to compensate the host family) and the Airport Transfer fee is forfeited.
- If you **CANCEL** your accommodation booking less than 48 hours before your arrival, you will be charged \$100 to cover administration costs and one (1) weeks Accommodation Fee (to compensate the host family) and the Placement Fee and Airport Transfer fee will NOT be refunded.

DEPARTURES

- Minimum stay a (1) week unless organised with Eastern Shores prior to arrival.
- Students who are staying with a Homestay family must give (2) weeks notice before leaving the homestay. If a new
 homestay family is required a fee may be required for reallocation of Homestay Accommodation. Unless due to a
 serious nature, which will be reviewed by ESI on a individual basis as student safety is our priority.
- If you choose to depart homestay early (after the 2 week minimum stay), either you or your agent must give ESI at least one (1) week's notice to depart, so that the balance of Homestay fees can be fully refunded to your nominated bank account.

REQUEST TO CHANGE HOMESTAY

• Students for any reason can request a change of homestay at the end of the initial booking period. A relocation placement fee \$150 will apply.

STUDENT'S CODE OF ETHICS AND GUIDELINES

As a student, he/she is to:

- Abide to the homestay rules and ESI Homestay Guidelines for Students.
- Must act maturely and responsibly at all times whilst living with a Homestay family.
- Is encouraged to communicate in an honest and respectful way thus developing a positive relationship both to the Homestay family and ESI.
- Be financially independent and can pay all Homestay fees and can meet all personal expenses such as travel, entertainment, telephone calls, medical expenses and other personal and incidental costs.
- Pay for any damages caused to the Homestay family property (if the student is responsible for the damage).
- Keep all valuables, money, passport and airline tickets in a safe place.
- Obtain travel insurance before leaving the country of origin, in addition to the required medical insurance, to cover all belongings and other incidental costs.
- Respect and be aware that cultural differences and beliefs of the Homestay family may differ from your own.
- Take relevant precautions to protect one's self and other individuals residing in the Homestay environment.
- Understand that breaking Australian law, verbal or physical aggression, repeated intoxication or inappropriate behaviour towards the Homestay family will be seen as a breach of contract. ESI will ask student to find alternative accommodation immediately at student's own cost, with no refund of monies already paid.
