Laws you must know:

All students must follow rules and guidelines from school or international supervisor

- By law, No buying or drinking alcohol if under age
- By law, No buying tobacco/cigarette products if under age 18
- By law, you must wear bike helmets when riding a bicycle.
- By law, you must always wear a seat belt when in a moving vehicle

BASIC SAFETY TIPS:

- If you are a strong swimmer and allowed to attend the beach, please ensure you **ONLY SWIM BETWEEN THE RED & YELLOW** flags with a life saver on duty.

NEVER SWIM ALONE OR AT NIGHT

- Do not open the door to strangers or unknown visitors.
- No burning candles in bedrooms.
- **ONLY ATTEND** functions or places with friends and host families. Do not accept drinks or drugs from anyone - **VERY HARMFUL**.
